# **Scott Metcalf** USMC 1967-70 Active 70-73 Res MIANG 1976 - 1997

I quit High School in 1966 and enlisted in USMC in 1967, two weeks after my 17th birthdayI landed



in San Diego, CA, at Marine Corps Recruit Depot. After boot camp (8 weeks), infantry training battalion(4 weeks), then on to Artillery Scout Observer School (MOS0846)(6 weeks), still can't go to Vietnam yet, off to Ft Sill OK attended Artillery Meteorologist School(10 weeks) still too young, off to Fort Sherman Panama task force to test M16, and attend modified Jungle Survival School(10 Weeks). Lots of guard duty then went off to Vietnam in 1968. I was attached to B/ co 1st Bn 4th Marines 3rd MARDIV as a Scout observer for seven months in I Corps(mainly Khe Shan Valley). Transferred to 12th Marines Artillery Ballistic Maternale an Station LZ Stud (later nerved Curptingham)

Meteorology Station LZ Stud (later named Cunningham) 6 more months, sent home got early out. 1976 working

for 7-Up as a driver, low man on the totem pole, only working a couple of days a week, needed a part-time job, sign up for the Michigan Air National Guard (MIANG) on a "Try One" enlistment, only one year then can get out. Join the 127th Communications Squad, Selfridge ANGB. After a while and some changes in Command, I decided I liked it. 21 Years later, I retired as the Senior Enlisted Advisor for the State of Michigan, also known as the *Command Chief Master Sergeant of the State*. Sometimes things work out.
