A long, long, time ago (1922) an idea was born by 23-year-old Amy Ross, "Find jobs for thousands of Detroit Veterans." Millionaire Corey Spencer caught wind of this idea and "gifted" 472 acres (about twice the total floor space of the Pentagon) of land to support her idea. So, in a land far, far away in Eaton Rapids, Michigan the VFW National Home was founded on January 7, 1925. In the spring of that same year the first family of seven – widow Mrs. Pollett and her six children were welcomed home!

On cold, windy, rainy, and dreary August 6, 2023 – I was humbled in the presence of three Centurions – 2 female Cooties and 1 male Veteran (*The Military Order of the Cootie (M.O.C.) is the Honor Degree of the Veteran of Foreign Wars of the United States of America*).– in the Parade of Checks where I was honored to present the Old Settlers Post of \$500.00 to the steeped in tradition to the Buddy Poppy Child. Total raised that day was \$31,000.00. There were at least 200 people in attendance – young and old – all pledging to *"Honor the dead by helping the living"* 101 years AFTER an idea was formed!!




Our new defibrillator was donated to the Post by the Lions Club and is located in the Hall.

Post Member Kevin DeBruyne Bio



I dropped out of High School in 1971 and spent the summer working for a friend of the family installing carpet and linoleum. By October I had enlisted in the U.S.Navy and was sent to San Diego for 11 weeks of boot camp. My first ship was a Guided Missile Destroyer, the USS Henry B. Wilson (DDG-7). We left for Vietnam in June of 72. On one occasion we had gone in close to take out an ammo dump and got caught in between the mainland and Hon Mieu Island in the Nha Trang Providence. We took heavy fire from their 16" guns and sustained considerable damage to the ship while still completing our mission. The ship had to go into Subic Bay P.I. to repair all the damage which took a few weeks. Then it

was back to the firing line for the remainder of 9 months and then back home. Eight months after getting back we went into the yards up in Long Beach for 6 months. I made E-5 while there and so I got transferred to a light cruiser USS Gridley (DLG-21). I wasn't there long and we headed back to Vietnam for another 9 months. I was fortunate to see a lot of the countries while over there from Japan down to Australia.

After discharge I went to work at Dodge Truck for a little over a year and then used my GI Bill to get into the skilled trades. I worked as a Machine Builder for a few years and moved up north of Grayling for nine years. When I moved back, I got into Aerospace Tooling and stayed with that until I retired.


