## Post Member John Disalvo Bio

Having enlisted in the United States Air Force (USAF) in October 1970, my journey began with a commissioning through Officer Training School (OTS) at Lackland AFB, Texas – a comprehensive three-month program encompassing both basic training and the academic rigors of USAF officer responsibilities. My background in Electrical Engineering, culminating in a Bachelor of Science degree, positioned me for a distinctive path within the USAF.

Shortly after, I underwent a rigorous 6-hour examination, evaluating my aptitude for pilot skills and airplane nomenclature. The outcome led to my inclusion in the Pilot Training Program at Moody AFB in Valdosta, GA, commencing on May 1, 1971. Over the next year, I navigated an intensive curriculum, alternating between flight sessions and academic pursuits, honing my skills in a variety of aircraft.

Pilot Training encompassed mastering the Cessna trainer (Cessna 172), the twin acrobatic jet Cessna T-37, and ultimately, the Northrop T-38 supersonic acrobatic twin-engine aircraft with an afterburner – also utilized by astronauts for maintaining flying proficiency.

Upon successful completion of Pilot Training, I assumed the role of a pilot for the C-141 Starlifter, a substantial 4-engine jet cargo plane with a global mission, including operations in Vietnam. My service in this capacity extended from June 1, 1972, to February 7, 1977, stationed at Dover and Charleston AFB.

Transitioning to civilian life, I joined Delco Electronics in Kokomo, IN. However, my passion for flying persisted, leading me to reenlist in the USAF Reserve (USAFR) at Grissom AFB on October 1, 1977. Here, I piloted the KC-135 Stratotanker, a formidable 4-engine jet air refueler with a weight exceeding 241,400 pounds, capable of supporting worldwide missions.

In August 1983, I furthered my military career by joining the 63rd Tactical Airlift Squadron at the Strategic Air National Guard (SANG) base in Detroit, MI. Specializing in the C-130 Hercules, a versatile four-engine turboprop cargo plane weighing 153,000 pounds, I played a pivotal role in operations during Desert Storm from October 1990 to May 1991.

Continuing my service until October 1993, I retired from the USAF with 22 years of dedicated commitment, achieving the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. My multifaceted career reflects a steadfast dedication to excellence in aviation and military service.

I believe the poem by John Gillespie Magee sums up my feelings about flying. It is something that unless you have flown by yourself in an aircraft that is solely under your control, you will never really understand the feeling of joy and accomplishment.







Oh! I have slipped the surly bonds of earth, And danced the skies on laughter-silvered wings. Sunward I've climbed, and joined the tumbling mirth Of sun-spit clouds, --and done a hundred things You have not dreamed of -Wheeled and soared and swung High in the sunlit silence. Hovering there I've chased the shouting wind along, and flung My eager craft through footless halls of air... Up, up the long, delirious, burning blue I've topped the wind-swept heights with easy grace Where never lark or even eagle flew--And, while with silent lifting mind I've trod The high untrespassed sanctity of space, Put out my hand, and touched the face of God.




